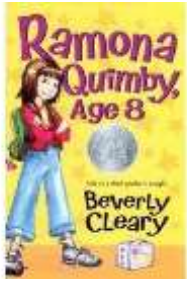


SCA Third Grade Summer Reading

You will need to purchase a (paperback) copy of this book, read the book over the summer, and bring it with you on the first day of school. For the first few weeks of school you will have skill lessons, vocabulary, daily grades and a final comprehension test.

In addition to reading the book, choose ONE of the following options to complete over the summer break. The completed project is due on the first day of school.

Option 1

After reading the book, choose your **favorite part** of the story. Write a paragraph (minimum of 5 sentences) describing the part and why you chose it as your favorite. Check your sentences for capitalization, punctuation, and complete thoughts. Illustrate your favorite part of the story on a separate piece of paper. Be sure to add detail and color your illustration.



Option 2

After reading the book, choose your **favorite character** of the story. Write a paragraph (minimum of 5 sentences) describing the character and why you chose it as your favorite. Check your sentences for capitalization, punctuation, and complete thoughts. Make sure and use *descriptive* words to tell about your paper. Illustrate your favorite character of the story on a separate piece of paper. Be sure to add detail and color your illustration.



Option 3

After reading the book, decide how the **setting of the story** is the same and how it is different from where and how you live. Draw and label a Venn diagram showing your results. Illustrate the setting in the book on a separate piece of paper. Be sure to add detail and color your illustration.
