

K.I.D.S. Schedule of Safety Topics

The following areas of safety will be addressed during the school year. While the teachers will be involved in the instruction of these topics, guest speakers will also be used for additional impact.

- October: Fire Safety Month
- Children will receive a visit from local firemen
 - Children will learn that firemen are our friends!
 - Children will learn the importance of checking smoke detectors
 - Children will learn the importance of having a fire safety plan at home
- January: Health/Nutrition Month
- Children will learn the difference between healthy and unhealthy food
 - Children will learn the importance of exercise
- February: Dental Health Month
- Four & Five Year Olds will visit a local dentist office
 - Three Year Olds will have a visit from a hygienist
 - Children will learn the importance of brushing their teeth
 - Children will identify foods that are good for their teeth
- March: Child Abuse Awareness Month
- Children will learn their bodies belong to God
 - Children will learn how to keep their bodies safe
 - Children will view a puppet show on “safe touches”, presented by the Carl Perkins Center
- April: Street & Bike Safety Month
- Children will learn importance of wearing a seat belt
 - Children will learn how to cross a street safely
 - Children will learn about bicycle safety
 - Children will participate in a Trike-A-Thon, proceeds going to St. Jude
