Toddler Information/Supply List

- 1. Please make sure that the child is here **no later than 8:00 a.m.** This is to help with the daily routine. Pick up is 3:00-3:15.
- 2. Pickup and dropoff should be done quickly so we do not disturb other children. Doing this will also establish a good daily routine.
- 3. Naptime is approximately 1.5 to 2 hours daily, if not longer.
- 4. Please make sure not to bring personal toys, as this can cause issues with the children. They can bring in a nap buddy, but it will need to remain in the backpack until naptime.
- 5. Toddlers are not allowed to walk around with their sippy cups and pacifiers in the classroom. They can have sippy cups at snack and lunch, and their pacifiers at nap time.
- 6. Morning and Afternoon snacks are not provided in the toddler room, since they are still figuring out allergies. Please make sure to send a sippy cup each day to be used at snack and lunch, and remember to send a snack each day.
- 7. Children will not be potty-trained in the toddler room.
- 8. A parent who wishes to speak to their child's teacher may call or come by the office to set up an appointment. After-school meetings are best, but meetings during the day may be arranged when additional staff are on duty or during naptime.

- 5 Packages Baby Wipes (used for clean up after snacks/lunch)

- 1 Backpack/Diaper Bag large enough to send daily notes and hold a change of clothes in a Ziploc bag with your child's name on it. These will be left in the backpack and should be changed according to the season and the growth of your child.

The following items will be kept in your child's cubby:

- Diapers/Pull-Ups (Only pull-ups with resealable/velcro sides should be sent). The Teacher will request more as needed.
- 3 Packages Baby Wipes (teacher will send home a note when more are needed)
- Diaper Cream
